PATHWAY OPPORTUNITIES

Pathway opportunities in New Zealand's PTEs can vary based on the provider and the programmes they offer. Some PTEs have articulation agreements with universities, polytechnics or other PTEs, which means you can move to a higher level programme in another provider.

Some common pathways include:

FOUNDATION PROGRAMMES TO HIGHER-LEVEL PROGRAMMES

Foundation programmes prepare you with the academic skills needed to enter higher level programmes.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES TO ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

Many PTEs offer English language programmes so you can achieve the language level needed to enter a programme in the PTE or in another provider.

DIPLOMAS TO DEGREES

After completing a diploma you may be able to continue studying at degree level, with the ability to transfer credits, depending on the programme and the provider.

DEGREES TO POSTGRADUATE

If you have completed a bachelor's degree, you can continue studying towards a postgraduate diploma or a master's degree, and students who have completed a postgraduate diploma can sometimes transfer credits to a master's degree.
